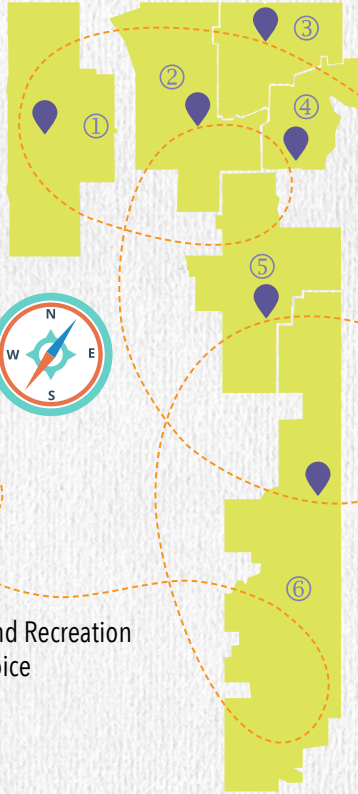

## FAIRWAY

### PETERSON PARK 6136 MISSION ROAD

Peterson Park is named after Fairway's longest serving (30+ years) mayor, Neale R. Peterson. The Park features tennis courts, a playground, shelters, a large open greenspace and the Fairway Swimming Pool.

## MERRIAM

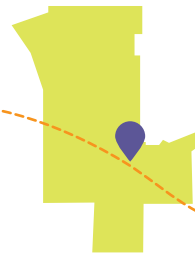
### CAMPBELL PARK 9674 W. 61<sup>ST</sup> ST.

Originally Referred to as "Old Horseshoe Bend" this park is located where 61st St. meets Turkey Creek. The park provides access to the Turkey Creek Streamway Trail and features a Play Booster swing with slides, climbers, bridges, ramps and enclosures as well as a double-bay swing set.

## MISSION

### PEARL HARBOR PARK 2925 MAPLE ST.

Local residents who survived this event have contributed to this memorial and actual memorabilia has been gathered for public viewing.
