

## Do I need a permit?

Yes, if you are working in the right-of-way.

### Where can I get a permit?

On the website under the Public Works/Admin & Engineering link for ROW Permit

### How much does a permit cost?

\$70

### Do I (Contractor) need a bond?

Yes. Permits require a performance and maintenance bond in the amount of \$5000, or the value of the work, whichever is greater. The bond is in effect for 2 years. Contractors working on a regular basis may consider a \$50,000 annual renewable bond. (Ch. 13-517 PV CODE)

### Do I (Homeowner) need a bond?

No. If you are performing the work yourself, you may get a permit without the bond requirement. However, if you have hired a contractor it is recommended for the contractor to get the permit in order to provide the maintenance bond (warranty) for the work performed.

## Working Hours

- Under 4 hours, does not require a permit. Please be respectful of traffic and neighbors.
- Over 4 hours, please go to website to obtain a permit for your activities.

- Flowable Fill
- Concrete to "minus 2 inches"
- APWA Type 3 for surface *or* OP-ILC mix for surface (Detail 205.01)

KCMMB 4K mix
