Dale Cole was born and raised in Kansas, served as an optometrist in the Army for 2 years and practiced for 35 years here in Salina, Kansas--retiring in May '06.

In the mid-1980's, Dr. Cole began taking photos during travels on missions with VOSH/International--an organization that does volunteer eye care work around the world. He would use the photos in slide presentations to local organizations. Over the years, photography 'developed' into a major part of his life. Since retiring, he now considers photography, plus golf and travel, his full-time "occupation"!

Having been on over 25 eye care missions and representing VOSH/International as President in 2004-5, Dr. Cole has seen some fascinating parts of the world. He shares many of the images from the various trips on his website www.dalecolephotos.com and now in his new book "Journeys—Around the World"—featuring 18 USA states and 17 foreign countries.

His photography has often been selected to be exhibited at the annual juried 5 State Photography competition sponsored by the Hays Arts Council, receiving a Jurors Award one year. He is published in various magazines. His work has also been exhibited at the Salina Country Club, Steifel of Salina, RG Endres Gallery in Prairie Village and Lindsborg's Birger Sandzen galleries. The Volunteer Connection has chosen his work several years for their Postcard Series.

Dr. Cole has been a member of local galleries since 1990, the latest being ArtXpressions Gallery where he and Stan Lauer were co-owners until it closed in January 2011.

His photography is presently being exhibited in many locations in Kansas—including Kansas Originals near Wilson, KS and the Travel Center near Goodland—both off Interstate I-70, Salina Museum Gift Store, Key Rexall Pharmacy in Salina and from his website.

RETURN THIS FORM

WHEREAS, the City of Prairie Village (the "City") permits art piece(s) to be displayed in the R.G. Endres Gallery, located at the Municipal Building, 7700 Mission Road, Prairie Village, Kansas (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS, the Building serves many functions, including, but not limited to a workplace and public meeting facility; and

WHEREAS, the City cannot and does not guarantee the art piece(s) will be insulated from loss, damage and/or theft; and

WHEREAS, the City maintains insurance policies for its property in the Building that may also cover any and all loss, damage and/or theft of art piece(s) displayed in and/or around the same.

WHEREAS, Richard Joseph Fudley Desires to display art piece(s) in and/or around the Building; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard Joseph Fudley, agree as follows:

1. All art piece(s) shall be appropriate for the many functions the Building serves.
2. All art piece(s) shall be displayed in a manner that will not:
 - (1) deface the Building or surrounding City property;
 - (2) block Building entrances, exits and/or hallways;
 - (3) violate any City ordinance; or
 - (4) impede working conditions or public meetings.
3. All art piece(s) shall be securely placed, to avoid injury to any persons present in the building.
4. The Prairie Village Arts Council is authorized to remove any art piece(s) in violation of Paragraphs 1, 2 or 3 above. I, Richard Joseph Fudley, agree to hold the City Harmless for any and all claims resulting from the removal of artwork pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2 or 3 above.
5. In the event any art piece(s) are damaged or stolen, the City will make all reasonable efforts to file a claim pursuant to the terms of any insurance policies maintained to insure property in the Building.
6. Should coverage be denied, I, Richard Joseph Fudley, agree to hold the City harmless for any liability, loss, damage and/or theft of any art piece(s) displayed in and/or around the Building.
