## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Steve Noll reported that the fountain at Tomahawk has been shut off for the winter. Mr. Pryzby advised that the lettering has been removed from the base of the fountain as it was incorrectly done and will be corrected and replaced. Some Council members felt that the lettering distracted from the fountain and did not feel it was necessary, others felt as a primary entry to the City it was appropriate. Al Herrera noted the correct installation of the lettering will be higher on the base and will be ground lit. Laura Wassmer and Mayor Shaffer commented on the number of positive comments that have been made regarding the statue.

Steve Noll asked if the artist's name could be identified on the fountain. Mr. Pryzby noted that her name and date are etched in the sculpture. Mr. Noll suggested that possibly a bronze plate identifying the sculpture and date could be added to the fountain. Mayor Shaffer noted that there would be a ribbon-cutting/dedication ceremony for the fountain next spring.
