## YOUR GUIDE FOR CURBSIDE TRASH, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE SERVICES **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017**

Effective January 1, 2017 the curbside trash, recycling and yard waste service will be provided by Republic Services. Please read this special edition of The Voice for important information about the upcoming changes. Please note that if your homeowners association currently provides trash service you should check with your association to see if any changes are proposed to your service.

## CURBSIDE PICK-UP INFORMATION

## **INFORMATION ABOUT TRASH COLLECTION**

- Your trash service will take place on the same day you currently receive service.
- The standard issue container size will be a 65 gallon trash cart. A 35 gallon and 95 gallon cart size are available; however you must call customer service at 913-281-4343 to arrange this option. Examples of cart sizes can be viewed at City Hall, (7700 Mission Road) Monday-Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- The carts will be delivered between December 15th and December 23rd. During this time of year, the weather can potentially cause problems and delays. Should a weather delay occur, Republic Services will finish the delivery on the 26th and the 27th of December.
- The trash cart will be blue with a matching blue lid.
- Please have your carts at the curb before 7:00 a.m. on your pick up day. It is possible that the new drivers may run the routes a little differently so the time of day you are currently getting picked up may change. It is important that everyone has their carts at the curb at 7:00 a.m.
- All trash must go in the carts. Additional bags that are outside of the carts must have overflow stickers on them. Republic Services will honor Deffenbaugh overflow stickers through March 31st, 2017.
- For proper placement at the curb, please make sure the hinges on the cart are always facing your home.
- Residents will be allowed to place one "bulky" item for disposal at the curb during the first collection of each month. The item can be no larger than 2' X 2' and must weigh less than 45 pounds.



#### **INFORMATION ABOUT YARD WASTE COLLECTION**

- Yard Waste will be picked up on the same day as the trash and the recycling. Please have all the yard waste at the curb by 7:00 a.m.
- Republic Services will pick up to 12 bags per week year-round. Additional bags will be picked up if it has an overflow sticker on it. Republic Services will honor Deffenbaugh overflow stickers through March 31st, 2017.
- Please avoid placing the yard waste bags behind the trash or recycling carts, or in a position where the driver may not see them.
- Yard waste can be place at the curb in one of three ways:
  - Bio-degradable yard waste bags.
  - Bundles that are tied by twine that are not longer than 48" and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds.
  - Trash cans may be used but they must be 35 gallon capacity or less. The cans must have lids, material cannot be sticking out of the top of the containers, and they cannot weigh more than 40 pounds.
- Yard waste cannot be placed in plastic bags.

## INFORMATION ABOUT RECYCLING COLLECTION

- Your recycling service will be on the same day as the trash service.
- The standard issue container size will be a 65 gallon recycling cart. A 35 gallon and 95 gallon cart size are available; however you must call customer service at 913-281-4343 to arrange this option. Examples of cart sizes can be viewed at City Hall (7700 Mission Road), Monday-Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- The carts will be delivered between December 15th and December 23rd. During this time of year, the weather can potentially cause problems and delays. Should a weather delay occur, Republic Services will finish the delivery on the 26th and the 27th of December.
- The recycling cart will be blue with a light blue lid.
- Please have your carts at the curb before 7:00 a.m. on your pick up day. It is possible that the new drivers may run the routes a little differently so the time of day you are currently getting picked up may change. It is important that everyone has their carts at the curb at 7:00 a.m.
- For proper placement at the curb, please make sure the hinges on the cart are always facing your home.
- A list of the acceptable and non-acceptable material is on the back page of this special edition.



#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Overflow Stickers will be sold for \$1.25 each at: Prairie Village City Hall, 7700 Mission Road Westlake Hardware, 4049 Somerset Euston Hardware, 6955 Tomahawk
- Normally, on holiday weeks Republic Services will provide service on a one day delay. However, with New Year's Day being on Sunday in 2017, the regular collection schedule will begin on Monday, January 2nd.
- Republic Services offers an "app" called "My Resources" that can be downloaded on your phone to allow you to communicate with a customer service representative.
- The customer service number is 913-281-4343
- The following Homes Associations provide their own waste management: Countryside East, Corinth Downs, Paddock Court, Corinth Place Villas, Town & Country, and Village Park
- The large item pickup dates have not been finalized; however, will likely occur in the spring of 2017
- Special collection for residents with verified hardships will continue. Please contact Republic Services or City Hall for further information.
- Deffenbaugh will notify residents directly as to their plan to coordinate cart collection.
